

Great lawns start with well-maintained mowers, and this springtime checklist has everything you need. Print off this checklist to help keep your Exmark mower running like new.



Check Tire Pressure

Properly inflated tires are critical for safety, efficiency, and handling. Refer to your owner's manual for the correct PSI for your tires.

Inspect Belts

Examine all belts for wear, tear, and cracks. Replace them as needed.



Check Hydraulic and Engine Oil

Make sure your oil is fresh for the season ahead. If not done during mower winterization in the fall, change it out now to maximize performance.



Inspect and Sharpen or Replace Blades

Sharp blades ensure a faster, cleaner cut and improve mower productivity and lawn health. If sharpening, make sure to wear the proper personal protective equipment.



Check Deck and Pump Idler Pivots

A routine inspection, and yearly zerk greasing, helps ensure smooth operation and optimal power transfer.

Clean the Deck

A thorough cleaning under the deck improves mower health and performance.



Replace Spark Plugs, Fuel and Emissions Filters

Fresh spark plugs and filters ensure easy starting and reliable performance throughout cutting season.



Use Fresh Fuel

If not done during mower winterization last fall, drain any old fuel in your machine. Then, refill the tank with fresh gasoline.
